8.4 QRPF Sections

L Vanderlinde raised the Issue that there was only two sections left (West & South Section) and do we really want sections in the QRPF. This was discussed at length and it was decided that at the next AGM this will be finalised.

8.5 Top 50 Results (10% Results)

B Snyman raised the issue that it was not clear on how this 10% clocking works. L Vanderlinde explained that members can clock multiple birds and the Top 50 velocity would go in this event on pigeon race net. It does not have to be filled in on the night it could be completed at home or forward your results to Len and he would put the velocities in to the pigeon race net program.

8.6 GPS tracking

J Knightley raised the issue if he could use his GPS tracking system. The management committee had no issues with this as long as basketing rules were still maintained.

8.7 Benzing Live

J Sheldrick requested if the QRPF would allow "Benzing Live/ Unicon Live" for all races. This was discussed at length and the Management committee would allow only for club races and would need to research how this could be accommodated in the future.

8.8 Club Clearances

J Sheldrick wanted clarity if the QRPF needed clearances when members moved between clubs in the QRPF. The management committee response was that it would be up to the clubs to seek financial clearances if they had any doubts about a member they accepted.

8.9 Pigeon virus

It was brought to the attention of the QRPF secretary on the weekend of the first race that there is a pigeon virus with similar symptoms as Rotavirus in some lofts in Brisbane but, was only affecting the young birds only a few lofts had contracted the virus. B Snyman requested if the QRPF representatives had heard of any reports about this virus? This was discussed at length and it was decided that the QRPF representatives would monitor the situation in their clubs and provide feedback the QRPF secretary should this Virus get of hand.
