8.5 Private Tosses

Members are just reminded that training pigeons are not to be released near the QRPF transporter and likely to interfere with birds homing from the race.

PRIVATE TOSSES (2002)

No member shall liberate any birds if likely to interfere with birds homing from a race.

8.6 Basket & Liberation Date

There was concerns raised that members are receiving info about liberation of race birds and the birds have not even being basketed. All corresponding with regards to basket and release of race birds will only be posted by QRPF Admin Secretary B Snyman or QRF Race Secretary L Vanderlinde. These posts will be on the QRPF race net program or via email or posted on the Brisbane racing pigeon Facebook page. Member with concerns about any issue are to contact their club representative who will then contact the QRPF secretary.

8.7 Weekend Weather concerns protocol:

Representative from club level that feel the weekend could provide challenging weather conditions are to contact the QRPF Admin Secretary by Thursday 5pm for Friday basket and Wednesday 5pm for a Thursday basket: Only once the QRPF Admin secretary has received 3 or more calls from representative clubs with concerns about the weekend weather will the QRPF management committee be called to vote with regards to options for alternative basket & release dates. It is the responsibility of the representative to contact all their members with regards to changes.

Liberation committee

The liberation committee will take responsibility once the birds are basketed and at the scheduled liberation point. The Liberation committee could also raise concern with the QRPF Admin secretary about challenging weather conditions for the upcoming weekend.
