1. President's opening remarks

3 Special Businesses

3.1 Race Schedule for 2020

L Vandelinde asked the members to first have a few discussions to get a feel for what the members want to have for the 2020 Schedule. This was discussed at length with many suggestions. It was moved by J Profke that we add a second Moonie to the 2nd series, second K Butters. **Carried** . It was also agreed that with the extra Moonie the schedule would be moved out a week to basket 29 September for 2 & 3 Oct release 2020.

The last race was discussed at length and K Butters moved a motion that we fly a Thargomindah with Naccundra on the last weekend, second P Gridley. **Carried**

There were no other motions and L Vanderlinde asked for a motion that we will accept the schedule with the changes for 2020 moved by J Profke, second M Van Roosmalen. **Carried.**

3.2 EBSS trapping rules for 2020

L Vandelinde outlined the situation with EBSS trapping rules. The decision was for members to enforce the EBSS trap rules or remove the rules. M Hooker opened the discussion with history behind why the EBSS trap rules were brought in a few years ago. The big concern was that birds were landing directly on the EBSS Pad. B Snyman stated that all members are compiling to the rules but the concern over the interpretation of the rules. The vote was called to gauge if the members wanted to keep the current rules or remove the rules. 19 In favour to keep current rules with 16 against.

L Vandelinde said that the basketing protocols for EBSS need to be enforced as clubs have become complacent with regards to EBSS entry sheets.

3.3 QRPF Year Book

L Vandelinde outlined the situation with the cost of year book and that all relevant info is available on the QRPF web page. This was discussed at length whether we should keep printing the yearbook. A vote was called with 19 in favour to no longer print the year book and 6 against .The year book will no longer be printed and all info about QRPF will be available on QRPF webpage.
